The Revitalization Committee continues to work with the Iowa Living Roadways Program.

On June 8th, a design workshop was held. Many members of the community stopped in at the Community Center to offer input for projects for the town. That evening, the revitalization committee met with members of the design team to review ideas that were gathered from the community input. Some of those ideas discussed were creating a rest area around Rainbow Bridge on the east side of Rockwell City, a school route plan that would connect both schools with the city square as well as Sunny View and improvements to the city square with both sidewalks and landscaping. The design team will continue to work on these ideas and will be discussed more

at the next meeting.
